To be eligible for an award, the nominee must be a paid member of a Toastmaster Club within District 64 on the date nominations close. Nominators must also be paid members of a Toastmasters Club within District 64 on the date nominations close.

The George Craigie Memorial Award recognizes members who don't normally enjoy recognition, but whose contributions have focused on their home club, through the encouragement of membership growth and retention, while continuing to contribute to the District wherever possible.

To nominate an individual for this award, please complete both Part 1 and Part 2 of this form. Part 1 identifies the nominee and the nominators. Please note that two nominators are required. Part 2 asks for a description of how the nominee fulfills the stated criteria for the award.
