How to Complete a CSP

1. Download CSP template from toastmasters.org.

- 2. Work with Executive committee and club to fill out goals, objectives to help focus planning to achieve 'Distinguished Club Status' (aka achieve goals in the Distinguished Club Program (DCP) of 5 or more points out of 10 possible).
- 3. Then gain shared agreement that it is achievable so that the members can commit to pursuing through the TM year.
- 4. Then upload the PDF to Club Central under Club Success Plan area.

How to upload the filled out CSPO template...

- 1. Log in to toastmasters.org
- 2. Click "Club Central"
- 3. Under Club Management Section ... Click "Club Success Plan"
- 4. Upload the filled out PDF template
