Greetings District 64

It is hard to believe we are halfway through the year. I have been watching the Dashboard. I like what I see. We have 61 clubs in good standing. There are 4 clubs who have reached their membership required for the year, other clubs have been working on Pathways. I am looking forward to seeing the progress we can make from now until June.

We have 3 possibly 4 new clubs forming shortly. I am happy to say that we have 6 club coaches this year. That is double from last year. Let's keep this growing. Please consider doing the club coach module in pathways. Being a club coach will help you achieve your DTM.

There are 2 new incentives coming out.

The first one is Talk Up Toastmasters which starts Feb. 1 and ends March 31. This program encourages toastmasters to invite people to their club to learn about Toastmasters. Should a club sign up or reinstate 5 new members to their club they will receive a special Talk of Toastmasters ribbon to display on their banner.

Second incentive - Beat The Clock runs from May 1 to June 30. The reward is similar to Talk Up Toastmasters adding five new, dual, or reinstate members between May 1 and June 30 and receiving a Beat The Clock ribbon to display on the club's banner.

The Ambassador Toastmasters program is going great. This incentive runs until June 30. Patrick Goodridge is in the lead right. I encourage you to continue visiting clubs in the District and earn yourself some points.

There are 16 clubs that are halfway to distinction.
